Condicionales: 1º tipo: if + present simple + will. 2ºtipo: if + pasado simple + would. 3º tipo: if + past perfect + would have participio.

Pasiva:

- Presente simple:

A: tom writes a letter. P: a letter is written by tom.

- Present continuous:

A: Tom is writing a letter. P: a letter is being written by tom.

- Past simple:

A: Tom wrote a letter. P: A letter was written by tom.

- Past continuous:

A: Tom was writing a letter. P: a letter was being written by

- Will:

A: Tom will write a letter. P: a letter will be written by tom.

- Futuro going to:

A: Tom is going to write a letter P: ... is going to be written.

- Would:

A: Tom would write a letter. P: a letter would be written by

- Present perfect:

A: Tom has written a letter. P: a letter has been written by...

- Present perfect continuous:

A: Tom has been writing a letter. P:.... has been beingwritte

- Past perfect:

A: Tom had written a letter. P: a letter had been written by...

- Past perfect continuous:

A: Tom had been written a letter. P:... had been beingwritte
